
Guided Reading Lesson Ideas:

- Photocopy the needed copies of the little book and staple them.
- Show the title page and read the title.
- This book is about apples.
- What do you know about apples?
- Give a book to each child.
- Go through the book page by page. This can be sung to 'BINGO'.
- Draw a picture on page 7 to show the child's favourite apple and write appropriate words in the blanks.
- When the book is complete, read it to a partner and group.
- Teach the high frequency words appropriate for your class or group.
 - Go through each page, and list words that may cause difficulties.
 - Put these words in phrases and sentences and practice reading them
 - Find these words in the book. Have the students highlight them if you wish.

Read these phrases/sentences: a fruit I love best oh
apples ripen it's time a ripe apple apple juice
apple sauce apple pie my favourite apple

- Use the words in the story to discuss the phonics you are teaching.
- There is no practice sheet with this book. The work is on page 7 of the book.
- Other activities: do graphing activities to show the favourite apple, make applesauce, cut apples to see the star and do stamping.
- Finally, have each child read the book aloud to you. Note the strategies the child uses and errors, if any. Then the child can take the book home to read.





